NOTICE.

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of the Ordinance 4th and 5th Victoria, No. 21, the Island of Rottneſt is conſtituted a Priſon, and by a Proclamation duly iſſued under the Proviſions of the 2nd Section of the ſaid Ordinance, and dated the 20th day of October, 1855, rules and regulations were made and promulgated touching the landing of boats at the ſaid Iſland; And whereas it is found difficult to guard againſt the ſurreptitious landing of evil diſpoſed perſons, in conſequence of the unreſtricted treſpaſſes of perſons on the adjacent rocks and iſlands, under the pretence of fiſhing or otherwiſe; And whereas ſuch rocks and iſlands conſtitute part of the Waſte Lands of the Crown, and it becomes neceſſary, as a precautionary meaſure for the preſervation of property, and for the ſafe cuſtody of the priſoners, to prohibit perſons landing thereon; *Notice is hereby given* that from and after the date hereof, the laws reſpecting treſpaſſes upon lands will be ſtrictly enforced againſt all perſons who ſhall treſpaſs on the iſland called Direction Iſland, or on any other of the rocks or iſlands adjacent to the ſaid Priſon-iſland, Rottneſt.
