PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency John Stephen Hampton, Esquire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia, and its Dependencies and Vice-Admiral of the same.

HEREAS it is expedient to establish a new Town in the Nelson District, to be called the Town of Bridgetown ;-Now Know YE, that I, the said Governor, in pursuance of the Authority in me vested, do hereby declare and proclaim that the Town of Bridgetown shall consist of all that piece or parcel of land situate in what is at present known as the Nelson District of the said Colony, containing Two thousand Four hundred acres, more or less, and bounded as follows, that is to say, on the South by a true east line of One hundred and eighty chains in length passing through a spot forty-eight chains twenty-two links from centre of a boundary post at the South East corner of Nelson location, No. 25, situate near a Bridge over the River Blackwood, at Geegelup: on the West by a true north line of One hundred and thirty-six chains seventy links, passing through a spot sixtyeight chains eighty-three links West from the corner aforesaid; on the North and on the East by lines parallel and equal respectively to the South and West boundaries hereinbefore described, and on the inner part by Nelson locations numbered 12 and 25.
