Such rates to be charged for each day of 24 hours; half rates only to be charged for less than 12 hours, and no charge to be made for less than 3 hours.

### SCALE OF CHARGES FOR IMPOUNDING ANIMALS.

Getting in from the bush, "laborer's wages" at 3s. 6d. per day for man, and 5s. per day for horse, and at the above rate for part of a day.

Mileage, taking into pound, 8d. per mile one way.
