Road from DARDANUP to ROE RANGE.

IT is hereby notified for general information that it is the intention of the Government to lay out and declare a line of public road, 33 feet wide, from the S.E. corner of Wellington location 61 at Dardanup, and thence eastward to the timber lands in Roe Range, as follows:—

From S.E. corner afore-said, the road will extend through the adjoining location 9, for 7 chains 70 links in direction south, 62 degrees east, then 50 chains south 60½ degrees east, and about 11 chains E. by S. to a proposed bridge across the River Ferguson; thence it will extend about 175 chains in a general direction northward of east, and 80 chains E. by S ½ S to the south boundary of location 9, crossing which it will extend for 40 chains on south side of that boundary to its east end, and thence among the timbered hills of the Roe Range.

Full particulars of this line will be published in a future notice, after the road shall have been laid out and surveyed; and the public are in the meantime cautioned against fencing across or otherwise obstructing the track above described.

IN order to remove all doubt as to the existence of a sunken danger about 52 miles true West by South from the west end of Rottneest Island, as reported in June, 1864, by the commander of the schooner "Beaver," and then called "Beaver Reef,"—it is hereby notified that the said reef is reported by Mr. Laing, commanding the schooner "Gift," to have been seen by him on the 15th instant, breaking heavily, in very nearly the position above indicated.

The reef appeared to extend about half a mile in a North and South direction, and soundings were had in 15 to 18 fathoms water a quarter of a mile from its south end.
