BUSSELTON COMMONAGE. ---0---

T is hereby notified for general information, that His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to appropriate, until further notice, for the use and benefit of the resident inhabitants on the Townsite of Busselton, under such Regulations as may from time to time be proposed in that behalf by the Busselton Town Trust and approved by the Governor, two thousand acres, more or less of land, according to the following boundaries; that is to say, on the *North* by a due west line of $162\frac{3}{4}$ chains from an inner south angle of Colorel Molloy's Sussex location No. 5, situate about 81 chains south from the southwest corner of Busselton Townsite: on the East by a due south line of $123\frac{1}{2}$

chains from angle aforesaid; on the South and on the West by lines parellel and equal to the north and east boundaries; and on the inner part by James Coppin's location b of 10 acres.
