TEMPORARY LIGHT NEAR THE GREAT BASSES.

ITH reference to the Notice issued by the Trinity House, London, dated 29th October, 1869, which appeared in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* of the 4th December, 1869, it is hereby notified for general information, that a Light-Vessel, exhibiting at an elevation of 38 feet above the sea a red revolving light at intervals of 45 seconds, has been placed in 12 fathoms low water spring tides, on a bearing N. N. E., and at a distance of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile from the N. E. rock of the Great Basses Reef, in latitude 6d. 10m. 37s. N. and longitude 81d. 28m. 11s. E.
