PROCLAMATION by His  
Excellency FREDERICK  
ALOYSIUS WELD, Esquire,  
Governor and Commander-  
in-Chief in and over the  
Territory of Western Aus-  
tralia and its Dependencies,  
&c., &c., &c.

**W**HEREAS, by an Ordinance of the  
Legislative Council of the said  
Colony, made and passed in the Twenty-  
seventh Year of the Reign of Her Most  
Gracious Majesty Queen Victoria, No. 21,  
entitled "An Ordinance for the recovery  
"of Small Debts and Demands," the  
Governor is empowered by Proclamation  
to constitute Local Courts for the recovery  
of Small Debts and Demands, to be  
holden at such times and places, and  
within such Districts throughout the said  
Colony, as may be most fit and conven-  
ient;

NOW THEREFORE I, the said Governor,  
do hereby notify and proclaim, and do  
hereby constitute a Local Court for the  
recovery of Small Debts and Demands,  
to be holden on the Third Thursday in  
each month, at the hour of eleven o'clock  
in the forenoon, at Northam, in the  
Toodyay District.

Given under my Hand and the  
Public Seal of the Colony, at  
Government House, Perth, this  
thirteenth day of December, one  
thousand eight hundred and  
seventy, and in the thirty-fourth  
year of Her Majesty's reign.
