WESTERN AUSTRALIA, PROCLAMATION by His to wit. Excellency FREDERICK ALOYSIUS WELD, Esquire, Governor and Commanderin-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

HEREAS, by an Act of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, made and passed in the 34th year of the Reign of Her Most Gracious Majesty Queen Victoria, No. 6, intituled "The Municipal Institutions' Act, 1871," the Governor is empowered by Proclamation to declare any Town in the said Colony to be a Municipality, and to define the boundaries of such Municipality, and the Wards therein, and the limits of each Ward; Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, do hereby notify and proclaim, AND DO HEREBY DECLARE the Town of Fremantle to be a Municipality, under the name, style, and title of "The Council and Burgesses of the Town of Fremantle"; and the Town of Guildford to be a Municipality, under the name, style, and title of "The Council and Burgesses of the Town of Guildford"; and the Town of Bunbury to be a Muncipality, under the name, style, and title of "The Council and Burgesses of the Town of Bunbury"; and the Town of Busselton to be a Municipality, under the name, style, and title of "The Council and Burgesses of the Town of Busselton"; and the Town of Albany to be a Municipality, under the name, style, and title of "The Council and Burgesses of the Town of Albany and the Town of Geraldton to be a Municipality, under the name, style, and title of "The Council and Burgesses of the Town of Geraldton"; AND I DO HEREBY proclaim and define the limits and boundaries of such Municipalities to be as follow :-

BOUNDARIES OF THE FREMAN-TLE MUNICIPALITY.

FIRST, OF FREMANTLE PROPER.

Bounded on the North-West by the entrance to Swan River; on the South-West by the shore of Arthur's Head and South Bay; on the South by a line of about 138 chains extending East from the Sea Shore, passing along the North boundary of Cockburn Sound Locations 7, 59, 61, 60, and 62; on the *East* by a North line of about 89 chains 55 links; and on the *North* by a South line of 32 chains 60 links from the shore of the River's entrance, through a spot 13 chains 70 links East from the summit of Cantonment Hill, and then East to the East boundary.

SECOND, OF NORTH FREMANTLE.

Bounded on the East by a North line of 34 chains 10 links from the North-East corner of Minim Cove; on the North by a West line to Sea Coast; on the West by the Sea Coast Northwards from Rous' Head; and on the South-East by the shore from Rous' Head to Minim Cove.

THIRD, RESERVES NOS. 1 AND 2 FOR SUBURBAN LOTS.

No. 1.-Bounded on the North by an East No. 1.—Bounded on the North by an East line from Sea Coast along South boundary of Fremantle Townsite to North-West corner of Cockburn Sound Location 7; on the West by the Sea Coast; on the East by the West boundaries of Locations 7, 134, and 26, and then by lines extending South 26 chains, West c chains and then South 7 chains 26 links. 8 chains, and then South 7 chains 26 links; and on the *South* by a West line to the Sea Coast.

No. 2.—Bounded on the North by lines ex-tending East 27 chains 10 links from the North-East corner of Location 62, then North 21 chains, and then East 20 chains; on the *East* by a South line of 41 chains; on the *South* by a West line of 46 chains 60 links; and on the *West* by the East boundaries of Locations 62 and 67.

BOUNDARIES OF THE GUILD-FORD MUNICIPALITY.

Bounded on the West by Swan River from Garden Point to the mouth of the Helena River; on the South by the Helena River and by location 20d and part of location 19; on the East by the Helena River; and on the North by Swan River upwards from Garden Point, then along a dyke on southern boundary of location 16, then South along said boundary until it meets an east line from the northern extremity of Garden Point, which due east line terminates the northern boundary at the Helena River.

Also that piece of ground comprised between location P and the south side of Swan Street, prolonged and lying between Swan River on the East and a North and South line on the West, to include 50 acres.

West, to include 50 acres. Also that piece of land known as West Guildford, lying between locations R & R 1 on the North, and location Q on the South, and between Swan River on the East and a North and South line on the West, to include 84 acres.

BOUNDARIES OF THE BUNBURY MUNICIPALITY.

FIRST, OF BUNBURY PROPER.

Bounded on the North and West by the Sea Coast; on the East by the Shore of Koombanah Bay and by Leschenault Inlet as far as Meredith Creek; and on the South by a West line from the mouth of Meredith Creek aforesaid to the Sea Coast, passing along the North boundary of Wellington location 26.

SECOND, OF NORTH BUNBURY.

Bounded on the *East* and *South* by Leschenault Inlet; on the *West* by the shore of Koombanah Bay and the Sea; and on the *North* by a West line of about 29 chains 20 links from Leschenault Inlet aforesaid to the Sea Coast, along the South boundary of Wellington location 24.

BOUNDARIES OF THE BUSSEL-TON MUNICIPALITY.

Bounded on the North by the shore of Geographe Bay; on the West by 90 chains of the East boundary of Sussex location 5, extending South from said shore; on the South by an East line of 80 chains; and on the East by a North line of about 111 chains to shore aforesaid: all bearings true.

BOUNDARIES OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPALITY.

Bounded on the North by a line extending to the summit of Craggy Bluff from a point on the West shore of Oyster Harbor, bearing due West from the summit of Green Island in the said Harbor; then by a line from the summit of Craggy Bluff aforesaid to a spot 10 chains true North from the edge of Duck Lake; on the West by a South line to the shore of Princess Royal Harbor; on the South-east by the shore of King George's Sound; and on the North-east by the shore of Oyster Harbor. Also, that portion of land round Mount Martin which lies westward of a line extending from the summit of Green Island aforesaid, to the summit of the largest "Bird Rock" lying off Point Spencer.

BOUNDARIES OF THE GERALD-TON MUNICIPALITY.

Bounded on the West by the Sea Coast; on the North by an East line of $130\frac{1}{2}$ chains from said Coast, passing through a spot 6 chains 83 links north from the north boundary of Victoria location 394; on the East by lines extending South 120 chains, West 100 chains, and South 256 chains 20 links; and on the South by a West line to Sea Coast aforesaid: all bearings being true or thereabouts, and measurements more or less.
