Scale of Charges for Impounding Animals.

Getting in from the bush, laborer's wages at 3s 6d. per day for man, and 5s. per day for horse, and at the above rate for part of a day.

Mileage, taking into pound, 8d. per mile one way.

Table of Sustenance in Private Pounds.

To be the same as in Public Pounds, but no fees for the Pound to be charged.
