WESTERN AUSTRALIA, PROCLAMATION by His to wit. Excellency FREDERICK ALOYSIUS WELD, Esquire, Governor and Commanderin-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

FRED. A. WELD,

HEREAS by the First Section of an Act passed in the 34th year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, No. 8, and intituled "An Act to "enable the Governor to extend the "'Fremantle Carriage Ordinance, 1868," "to other Towns," power is given to the Governor of the said Colony to extend the provisions of such Ordinance to such other Towns as he may deem expedient; Now THEREFORE I, Frederick Aloysius Weld, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the said Colony, no hereby notify and proclaim that I have extended the provisions of the said Ordinance to the Town of Guildford.
