THE following amended By-Laws, for regulating the proceedings of the Bunbury Municipal Council, to take the place of Nos. 1 and 3 hitherto in force, have been confirmed by His Excellency The Governor in Executive Council.

1. The Bunbury Municipal Council shall meet in the Mechanics' Hall, for the transaction of business, on the second Monday in every month, or oftener if necessary; each Meeting to commence at 7 o'clock, p.m.

3. The Collector for the time being, appointed by the Council, shall have the necessary legal power and authority to demand and collect all Rates, Assessments, License fees, Fines, Tolls, Forfeitures, and other sums due to the Council, and his receipt shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the same; the periods for collection of such dues to be fixed by the Council at the time this rate is declared. And all sums so collected shall be handed over to the Treasurer by the Collector at least once a week, and such sums shall be weekly forwarded to the Bank by the Treasurer, if amounting to five pounds, under a penalty not exceeding twenty shillings.
