130.—Nothing in these Regulations contained shall be deemed to apply to auriferous lands.

131.—Before any Mineral Lands are abandoned or forfeited, it shall be obligatory on the occupant to inclose, by a substantial fence, all shafts and dangerous cuttings made by him during his occupancy.

IS Excellency The Governor has been pleased to approve of the following additional Regulation, applicable to Convicts holding Conditional Releases :-

"Any Conditional Release Holder who shall be convicted before any one or more Justice or Justices of the Peace of selling or retailing, either for himself or for any licensed or unlicensed person, any ale, beer, wine, or other spirituous or fer-mented liquor, or of being retained or employed in the care, charge, conducting, or management of any house or place in which a Publican's General License, a Wine and Beer License, or a Wayside House License is exercised, shall at once forfeit his Conditional Release, and shall be liable to be remitted to prison and to revert to his original sentence of Penal Servitude."

### The Bankruptcy Act, 1871.

#### IN THE SUPREME COURT OF WESTERN Australia.

In the matter of James White Humphrey, of Fremantle, Auctioneer, Commission Agent, Dealer, and Chapman, a Bankrupt.

Colony of Western Australia, Auctioneer, has been appointed Trustee of the property of the Bankrupt. The Court has appointed the Public examination of the Bankrupt to take place at The Supreme Court House, on the twenty-eighth day of July, 1873, at eleven o'clock in the forenoon.

All persons having in their possession any of the effects of the Bankrupt must deliver them to the Trustee, and all debts due to the Bankrupt must be paid to the Trustee.

Creditors who have not yet proved their debts must forward their proofs of debts to the Trustee.
