OTICE is hereby given, that whereas under and pursuant to the provisions of an Act passed in the thirty-seventh year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled "An Act to further regulate the importation of Cattle, Sheep, and Pigs," His Excellency The Governor in Executive Council was pleased to make an order that for a period of two years the importation of cattle, sheep, and pigs into Western Australia from all places beyond the Australasian Colonies was prohibited, and that such period should be taken to commence from the date of the publication of a notice to the above effect in the London "Times"; and whereas such notice was published in the said "Times" newspaper on the thirtieth day of September, in the year of our Lord One

thousand eight hundred and seventy-three; and whereas it has appeared to the Governor in Executive Council expedient on sanitary grounds to make an order prohibiting the importation of the said animals from any place beyond the Australasian Colonies as aforesaid for a further period, to wit, from the expiration of the prohibition aforesaid up to the thirtieth day of June, which will be in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventysix, His Excellency The Governor in Council aforesaid has made an order prohibiting the importation of cattle, sheep, and pigs from all places beyond the Australasian Colonies during the interval that will elapse between the thirtieth day of September next and the thirtieth day of June in the year One thousand eight hundred and seventy-six; and in the said order the said Governor in the said Council has declared that any person offending against the terms of the said order shall be liable, for every such offence, to a penalty of Fifty pounds, and that any cattle, sheep, or pigs imported into the Colony contrary to the terms of the said order shall be seized and destroyed.

# Second Series. THIRTY-FIFTH NOTICE.

S.O.L.—AVON (Hastings').

Bounded by lines starting from the South-west corner of Avon Location 552, where it joins the northern boundary of Location W, and extending West-south-west 17 chains 88 links, North-north-west 25 chains, West-south-west 23 chains, North-north-west 15 chains, East-north-east 35 chains 88 links, South-south-east 12 chains, East-north-east 5 chains, and South-south-east about 28 chains, to the starting point. All bearings magnetic, and measurements more less. Content—100 acres.

#### S.O.L.—AVON (Gale's).
