Perth City Council.

HEREAS the Perth City Council are empowered by the 43rd section of "The Municipal Institutions' Act, 1871," to borrow by way of mortgage on the credit of their annual revenues certain monies for or towards or incidental to the making, carrying on, or completing any permanent improvements, within their Municipality: And having so borrowed a certain sum of money in pursuance of such power for the said purpose, it is incumbent upon them to assess and collect a general rate, not exceeding sixpence in the pound, for each half-year until the said debt shall have been thereby paid; such general rate to be in addition to the annual rate in the said Ordinance mentioned: Now, therefore, the said City Council, in pursuance of the power and authority contained in the said section, do hereby assess and declare, from the date hereof, a general rate of sixpence in the pound for each half-year upon all rateable property within the limits of their Municipality until the said debt shall have been thereby paid, and such general rate to be in addition to the annual rate in the said Ordinance mentioned.
