T is hereby notified, for general information, that under the provisions of "An Act to establish Local Boards for the conservation, improvement, and making of roads in the several Districts of the Colony," His Excellency The Governor has been pleased to designate the colony of the colony nate and define the following District as a Road District under the said Act, viz. :-

## MURCHISON ROAD DISTRICT.

MURCHISON ROAD DISTRICT.

Bounded on the West by a line extending North from the Coal Seam on the Irwin River till it strikes the Murchison River, and South till it strikes the North boundary of the Irwin Road District; on the North-west by the Murchison River upwards to a spot due West from Mount Murchison; on the North by a due East line passing through the summit of Mount Murchison; and on the South by the North boundary of the Irwin Road District. The boundaries of those parts of the Nicol Bay, Mines, Geraldton, and Greenparts of the Nicol Bay, Mines, Geraldton, and Green-ough Road Districts lying within the boundaries hereinbefore described are limited as far as they are interfered with thereby.
