WHEREAS the Legislative Council now stands prorogued until Thursday, the thirtieth day of September, instant, and whereas it is expedient further to prorogue the same; Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, in exercise of the powers in me vested, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Legislative Council from Thursday, the thirtieth day of September, instant, until Saturday, the thirtieth day of October, now next ensuing.

FORTY-SECOND NOTICE.

MELBOURNE (*W. Padbury's*)—500 acres.

Starting from a spot on the North boundary of Location 219; at the distance of 3 chains 46 links from its North-east corner, and extending North 40 chains, West 78 chains 40 links, North 39 chains 42 links, East 102 chains 16 links, South 52 chains 2 links, East 80 links, then South 27 chains 40 links, and finally West 24 chains 50 links to the starting point. Subject to a road.

MELBOURNE (*Padbury, Loton & Co.*)—164 acres.

On the South and East by West and North lines of 70 chains, and 23 chains 33 links from a spot 7 chains 33 links South, from the North-west corner of Location 66; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal, and bearings true.

WELLINGTON (*Busher's*)—110 acres.

On the North and East by lines extending West 40 chains, and South 27 chains 50 links from a spot about 76 chains West, and 3 chains 50 links North, from the North-west corner of Location 197; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal.

WELLINGTON (*Higgins'*)—100 acres.

On the North and West by lines extending East 40 chains, and South 25 chains from a spot on the East boundary of Tillage Lease 7147, 20 chains South from its North-east corner; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal.

WELLINGTON (*House's*)—100 acres.

On the North and East by lines extending West 30 chains, and South 33 chains 33 links from the North-west corner of Location 287; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal.

SWAN (*Mews'*)—100 acres.

On the North-east by 38 chains 73 links of the South-west boundary of Location X. On the North-

west by the South-west boundary of Special Occupation License 647, measuring 25 chains 82 links; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal.

SWAN (*Taylor's*)—100 acres.

On the *Northward* by 16 chains 20 links of the road from Perth to Fremantle. On the *Westward* by the East and South boundaries of Location 621, measuring respectively 14 chains 51 links, and 16 chains by part of the East, and the whole of the South boundary of a Public Reserve, and by a South line of about 9 chains 50 links. On the *South* and *East* by Location 642, and a Public Road.

SWAN (*Anderson's*)—175 acres.

On the *North*, *East*, and *South* by Locations 103, 113, 285, 619, 477, and 423. On the *West* by about 59 chains 90 links of a public road.

SWAN (*Byrnes'*)—100 acres.

On the *South* by a West line of 32 chains, passing along part of the North boundary of Location 694. On the *West* by a North line of 31 chains 62 links. On the *North* by an East line of 34 chains; and on the *East* by a public road.

WILLIAMS (*Hayes'*)—100 acres.

On the *North* and *East* by lines extending West 30 chains and South 33 chains 33 links from a spot 16 chains 66 links North and 15 chains East from a marked tree, the said tree being situate about 200 chains in direction about West-by-North from Geeralying Spring; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal.

KOJONUP (*Whitehead's*)—100 acres.

On the *South* by an East line of 23 chains 81 links. On the *West* by a North line of 42 chains from a spot 232 chains East and 100 chains North from the South-west corner of Pastoral Lease A 1012; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal, and bearings true.

AVON (*Pettit's*)—100 acres.

On the *Southward* and *Westward* by lines extending East-north-east 40 chains, and North-north-west 25 chains from a gum tree marked with two squares, situate 23 chains East-north-east and 10 chains North-north-west from the North-west corner of

Avon Location C; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal, and bearings magnetic.

AVON (*Reynolds'*)—100 acres.
