Transfer of Land Act, 1874.

- 1. In order to enable persons to avail themselves of the advantages conferred by this statute applicants are hereby informed that they will have in the first instance to procure a form of application from the Office of Titles Perth or at the office of the Resident Magistrate of the several districts in the Colony.
- 2. The applicant when he shall have filled up his application will sign the same in the presence of the Registrar of Titles or in the presence of any Justice of the Peace or of a Notary Public who must likewise append his signature thereto.

Any number of pieces of land even when not adjoining one another may be included in one application.

3. The applicant will bring or cause to be left at the Office of Titles the application together with all documents concerning his title.

The application fee must be paid at the time of making the application.

- 4. Expenses:
  - a. In the case where the applicant is the original holder of a grant from the Crown and where no transaction affecting the land in question has been previously registered a Certificate of Title may be obtained for twenty-five shillings inclusive of application fee but there is also a charge of a half-penny in the pound sterling on the value of the land.
  - b. In the case where transactions affecting the property in question shall have been previously registered the scale of application fees is higher but in no instance exceeds fifty shillings and in such cases notice of the application is required to be advertised and the applicant must be prepared to pay the cost of such advertisement.

Further information will be from time to time notified and may be obtained free of charge at the Office of Titles during business hours.

# Second Series. FORTY-THIRD NOTICE.

VICTORIA (Duncan's).-150 acres.

On the South-west and North-west by lines extending South-east 40 chains and North-east 37 chains 50 links from the North corner of Tillage Lease 4155; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal, and bearings true.

#### VICTORIA (McAuliffe's).-100 acres.

On the North and West by lines extending East 33 chains 33 links and South 30 chains from the Southwest corner of Tillage Lease 4564; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal, and bearings true.

# VICTORIA (Adlam's).-100 acres.

On the South-east by 18 chains 30 links of Philips Road. On the North-east by the South-west boundary of Location 799, measuring 54 chains 64 links; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal, and bearings true.

#### VICTORIA (Smith's),-100 acres.

On the North-west by 33 chains 33 links of Philips Road. On the North-east by the South-west boundary of Location 229, measuring 30 chains; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal, and bearings true.

## VICTORIA (King's).—123 acres.

On the North-west and North-east by lines extending South-west about 37 chains 93 links and South-east 33 chains 33 links from the Western corner of Location 782; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal, and bearings true; the precise boundaries to be determined by Survey, and the South-west boundary must be at least 3 chains above high-water mark. Bearings true.

#### VICTORIA (Linthorne's) .- 100 acres.

On the North-west by about 22 chains of the Northeast boundary of Tillage Lease 3533, and by the left bank of the Greenough River downwards to the Northeast boundary of Location 726. On the South-west by a South-east line of about 26 chains of said North-east boundary. #### AVON (Hastings') .- 250 acres.

chains 67 links, North-north-west 27 chains, East-north-east 10 chains, South-south-east 21 chains 51 links, East-north-east 4 chains, South-south-east 17 chains 54 links, West-south west 20 chains, South-south-east 50 chains, West-south-west 34 chains 16 links, South-south east 10 chains, West-south-west 5 chains 88 links, and North-north-west 72 chains 5 links, passing along part of the East-north-east boundary of aforesaid Location U to the starting point. All bearings magnetic.

#### AVON (Meares') .- 100 acres.

On the Southward and Westward by lines extending East-north-east 40 chains and North-north-west 25 chains from a spot 5 chains South-south-east and 2 chains West-south-west from Boyaking Well; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal, and bearings magnetic.

#### AVON (Davies') -100 acres.

On the South-west by the Clackline Road. On the North-west by an East-north-east line of about 40 chains, passing along the South-east boundary of Location 703. On the North-east by a South-south-east line of 30 chains; and on the South-east by a West-southwest line of 29 chains. All bearings magnetic.

#### AVON (White's) .- 100 acres.
