THE following By-Laws, as amended, compiled, and passed by the Fremantle Municipal Council, have been confirmed by His Excellency The Governor, with the advice of his Executive Council.

No. 16.—Any owner or occupier of any house, shop, store, or other building within the boundaries of the Municipality whose roof shall overhang or project over any thoroughfare or footway without having a proper gutter and pipe to carry off the rain, or who shall construct or have any cornice, crane, hoist, or any other fixture or projection overhanging or upon any footway or thoroughfare, save and except any awning, projection, or erection, whether fixed or not, in the nature of an awning approved in writing by the Chairman of the Council, shall forfeit and pay for every such offence any sum not exceeding £5, for every month such nuisance shall continue and remain, after fourteen days' notice to remove the same shall have been given in writing by the' Inspector of Nuisances or the Chairman of the Council.

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No. 17.—Any ratepayer desiring to make or erect any awning, or any projection in the nature of any awning or overhanging the footway of any street, in front of his shop, house, or premises, shall apply for permission so to do, in writing, to the Chairman of the 'Council, and at the same time furnish a plan and specification of the work which the ratepayer is desirous of effecting.

No. 18.—That no Contractor for any work or material for the Municipality shall, after the first December next, be allowed to hold office as Chairman or Councillor.

Transfer of Land Act 1874

NOTICE

HEREAS it is provided by § 15 of the above Act that "The grants in fee or for years of all Crown Lands remaining unalienated at the time of the commencement of this Act" [that is to say July 1st 1875] "shall be delivered not to the grantee but to the Registrar who shall retain the same &c"

And whereas many such grants have been delivered to the grantees and not to the Registrar and are now in the possession of the grantees or of their transferees or of other persons not being the Registrar

And whereas all transactions taking place with respect to such lands are void unless they shall have been done in conformity with the provisions of the above Act

Now it is hereby ordered that all persons having in their possession grants from the Crown bearing a date subsequent to the above mentioned day shall forward the same to me together with all conveyances or charges or any memoranda purporting to convey or to charge or to affect the land the subject of such transactions And shall also forward at the same time a declaration in writing attested by a Justice of the Peace or notary public *either* declaring that there have not been nor are any transactions affecting the land *or* that there have not been nor are any transactions other than those which are forwarded at the same time with the Crown grant

And such grantees shall receive in exchange for the grant a certificate of title and in the cases where the grantees have not possession the land will be conveyed charged or otherwise disposed of in accordance with the terms of the conveyances charges or other transactions which have taken place but conformably with the provisions of the Act

Notice to the Public.

ON and after this date any person requiring traced or other copies of the whole or part of any maps or plans in the Surveyor General's Office may obtain the same on the following conditions only, as no officer is now allowed to furnish them on his private account, as heretofore :---

1. Applications for tracings or plans must be made in writing, addressed to the Surveyor General, and a deposit of ten shillings accompany each.

2. The charge made is at the rate of two shillings and sixpence for each hour, or portion thereof, a draftsman is occupied; this includes materials found.

3. Each tracing or plan will be marked with an official stamp, and bear a number as well as a note of the cost of its execution; if such should be less than the ten shillings deposited on application, any balance will be returned when the tracing or map is delivered to the depositor.

4. Tracings or plans applied for will be for-forwarded free of post to the applicant, but in all cases *full* payment for them is required to be made before delivery is given.
5. Every exertion will be made to furnish

5. Every exertion will be made to furnish tracings and plans promptly in the order they are applied for, but no guarantee can be given that they will be delivered within any specified time.
