IN THE SUPREME COURT.

In the matter of Richard Delaporte, of Bunbury, in the Colony of Western Australia, Publican, a Bankrupt.

W HEREAS at a meeting of creditors held under this bankruptcy on the third day of August, One thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, pursuant to notice given in the Western Australian Government Gazette, it was resolved by a majority in number and three-fourths in value of the creditors then present or duly represented at the said meeting, that a composition offered by the bankrupt for payment of the debts owing by him was calculated to benefit the general body of the creditors under the estate, and should be accepted by the trustee of the property of the bankrupt.
