HEREAS the Legislative Council now stands prorogued until Wednesday, the 14th day of March next, and whereas it is expedient further to prorogue the same; Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, in exercise of the powers in me vested, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Legislative Council from Wednesday, the fourteenth day of March next, until Monday, the 14th May, next ensuing.
