FOR THE DESPATCH OF BUSINESS, in the Legis-
lative Council Chamber, in the City of Perth,
at the hour of three o'clock in the afternoon;
and the MEMBERS of the said Legislative
Council are hereby required to give their
attendance at the said time and place accord-
ingly.

appointment, are not included in the word
family.
