At Bunbury, on Tuesday, October 30th, at 4 a.m.

At Busselton, on Tuesday, October 30th, at 10 a.m.

At the General Post Office, Perth :—

Money Orders for transmission by the above conveyances will be issued on the United Kingdom, the Australian Colonies, New Zealand, and Tasmania, up to 10 a.m., on Saturday, 27th October.

Letters for Registration must be posted one hour before the closing of the Mails.

Late Letters, on payment of a fee of 6d., may be posted one hour after the closing of the Mails.

Newspapers must be posted one hour before the closing of the Mails, otherwise they will not be forwarded until the next Mail.
