HEREAS by "The Imported Stock Act, 1876," it is provided that it shall be lawful for me, the said Governor, to acquire and set apart by Proclamation in the Gazette one or more Quarantine Stations on which the necessary sheds and appurtenances may be erected for the purpose of the said Act; and whereas it is deemed expedient by me, the said Governor, to set apart a Temporary Quarantine Station at Guildford; Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, in exercise of the powers in me vested, as aforesaid, do hereby set apart as Temporary Quarantine Station at Guildford, for the purposes of the said Act, and until the first day of December next, all that piece or parcel of land situate in the town of Guildford. being Guildford Town Lots Nos. 61 and 62: Bounded on the South by 3 chains 82 links of Swan Street. On the East by Guildford Town Lot 60, measuring 11 chains 20 links. On the West by Guildford Town Lot 63, measuring 10 chains 30 links; and on the North by a straight line between the North ends of the East and West boundaries.

Given under my hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the said Colony, this twenty-ninth day of September, 1879.

ARTHUR'S HEAD LIGHTHOUSE. Lat. 32° 03' 14" S., long. 115° 45' 12" E.

On and after the 1st proximo, the new Lighthouse, which has been erected on Arthur's Head, at the South side of entrance of Swan River, will be illuminated.

The new structure is situated some 10 yards North of the old building. The tower (stone) is round, with a base of 22 feet clear. Height above high water mark to centre of lantern, 92 feet; and the building from base to vane is 71 feet. Level of site above high water, 32ft. 1½in. It has a Third Order fixed dioptric light (white) for 190°, and is visible for about 16 miles from the deck of a vaced 16 miles from the deck of a vessel.
