- 2.—That of August, 1856, one of Friendship, Commerce, and Navigation, on the 28th August, 1878.

THE following Rules and Regulations adopted by the Board of Management of the Dongarra and Milo Commonages have been approved by His Excellency the Governor.

By His Excellency's Command,  
**ROGER TUCKER GOLDSWORTHY,**  
Colonial Secretary.

1. That no persons excepting travellers be allowed to run any stock on the Commonages who are not *bonâ fide* owners or occupiers of Purchase Tillage Lease or Special Occupation Lands within the boundaries of such Commonages, or within 40 chains of said boundaries.
2. That no person be allowed to run any sheep on the Dongarra Commonage, within three miles of the Police Station, without the express permission in writing of the Board.
3. That the persons defined in Rule 1 be entitled to free run on the Commonage for 5 head of horses or cattle and 20 sheep for each 100 acres. Provided

that every person running sheep is to notify the fact and the number of sheep to the Commonage Board within seven days of their first running thereon.

4. That the persons defined in Rule 1 may run horses, cattle, and sheep, in excess of the number allowed in Rule 3, on payment of 1s. per head per annum for large stock, and 3d. per head per annum for sheep. Licenses to run from date of issue to the end of the then current year. Provided that no one person shall run more than 50 head of large stock and 100 sheep on the Commonage.

5. That no sheep be allowed to encamp on any Commonage, except travelling sheep or those moving from one part of the District to another.

6. That in the event of applications for land within the Commonage being referred to the Board no recommendation thereon shall be made except at a meeting at which four members are present.

7. Persons using the Commonages contrary to these Regulations will be treated as trespassers, and the Board will put in force the Act against such.

8. That all revenue derived from the Commonages be devoted solely to such improvements upon them as the Board shall think fit.

9. That these Regulations come into force so soon as they have received the approval of His Excellency the Governor, and due publicity has been given thereto.
