By His Excellency SIR WILLIAM CLEAVER FRANCIS ROBINSON, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas the Legislative Council now stands prorogued until Friday, the eighth day of April next, and whereas it is desirable that the same should sooner meet; Now therefore I, the said Governor, in exercise of the powers in me vested, do hereby announce and proclaim that a Session of the Legislative Council of Western Australia shall be holden for the Despatch of Public Business, on Monday, the twenty-first day of March next ensuing, at two o'clock in the afternoon, in the Legislative Council Chambers, in the City of Perth, within the said Colony; and the Members of the said Legislative Council are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the said Colony, this nineteenth day of February, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-one.
