The number of men actually necessary for driving in Stock only shall be allowed for; and in the event of the Stock being the property of several owners, each shall only be required to bear an equal proportion of the cost of driving in, and shall not (each) be charged the whole amount.

Actual cost of advertisements, published strictly in accordance with the requirements of the Trespass Act, will be allowed; if several animals are included in one advertisement, cost to be apportioned.

The Justice or Justices who may make an Order for Sale of Stock (where the owner is not ascertained) to approve of charges made by impounder, not exceeding the rates here specified.
