We much regret that owing to circumstances we have been unable to avail ourselves of the invitation of His Excellency the Governor to visit the Capital of the Colony.

We shall ever cherish a grateful reminiscence of the kindly loyalty we have experienced from all the Queen's subjects at this our first landing-place in Australia.
