Notice to the Public.

Postage Stamps for deposit in Post Office Savings Banks by School Children.

T is hereby notified, for general information, that in order to encourage thrift among School Children, it has been decided by His Excellency the Governor that from and after the 1st of August next postage stamps of the value of one shilling, when affixed to the cards provided by the Department for this purpose, be received as deposits in any Post Office Savings Bank. Every pupil attending any school, who may wish to save one shilling by penny contributions for ultimate deposit in the Post Office Savings Bank, may do so by purchasing with every penny so saved a penny postage stamp and affixing it to the card. When the squares are filled, the card may be taken to any Post Office Savings Bank, where it will be received by the Postmaster, who will accept it either as the first deposit in a new account then to be opened, or as a subsequent deposit, if the depositor has already opened an account.

If any stamps affixed to the cards are defaced or otherwise damaged, it will result in the rejection of the entire number.

The cards for the collection of postage stamps, and intended for distribution either to schools or to the children attending schools, may be obtained at every Post Office Savings Bank, where further information will be afforded.
