PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency SIR WILLIAM CLEAVER FRANCIS ROBINSON, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by the third section of "The Stamp Act, 1881" (the 44th Vict., No. 20), it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall commence on such day after the 30th day of September next as the Governor may by Proclamation, to be inserted one calendar month beforehand, appoint: Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers and discretions vested in me, as aforesaid, do by this my Proclamation appoint the 1st day of November next ensuing as the day on which "The Stamp Act, 1881," shall commence; and the same shall commence and take effect on and after that day accordingly.
