Swedish and Norwegian Legation, London, 19th March, 1882.

My Lord,—Acting upon instructions received from my Government, I have the honor to inform Her Majesty's British Government that the new system of measurement of vessels comes into opersystem or measurement of vessels comes into operation in Sweden on and after the 1st April next, and that a partial remeasurement of steam vessels belonging to Great Britain and to the Colonies will take place in Swedish Ports after that date, in order to determine the deduction for the engine room, in conformity with the method adopted in Sweden.

While acquitting myself of the duty imposed upon me, I have at the same time the honor to offer you, my Lord, renewed expressions of my most distinguished consideration.
