By His Excellency SIR WILLIAM CLEAVER FRANCIS ROBINSON, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

HEREAS it is provided by "The Sandalwood Act, 1881," that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council from time to time to proclaim and define one or more area or areas of Waste Lands of the Crown within which no live or growing Sandalwood tree shall be cut or grubbed up for the period to be named by the Governor in such Proclamation; Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim and define the Waste Lands of the Crown contained and being within the following area to be an area within which no live or growing Sandalwood tree shall be cut or grubbed up during the period of three years from the date hereof:—"Bounded by "lines starting from the Coast line Eastward of "Point Irby, and extending in a general North-"westerly direction, parallel or thereabouts, to and "at the distance of ten miles North-east from the "Pallinup River to a spot ten miles North from "Mullidup; thence by a straight line to Etakup; from thence following the Gordon River downwards "to the Gordon River Bridge, on the Perth-Albany "Road; thence by the road aforesaid towards Albany "to the point of junction with it of the Cape Riche "Road; from thence Eastward along the last-named "road to Cape Riche; and from thence by the Coast "line to the starting point."

Given under my hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the Colony, this thirteenth day of January, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-three.
