AUSTRALIA.

SOUTH COAST-PORT PHILLIP ENTRANCE. (1) REMOVAL OF LIGHTNING ROCKS.

Information has been received from the Government of Victoria, dated 11th September, 1882, that Lightning rocks, in the entrance to port Phillip, have been removed, and that there is now a least depth of 32 feet over and around their positions:—

Also, that the depths—over the patches of 25-28 feet, 28 and 29 feet, which existed about 3½ cables north-west of the position of Lightning rocks; and over that of 29 feet about 2 cables south-east of that position—have been increased to 30 feet.

EAST COAST.

(2) ROCKS IN MOURILYAN HARBOUR ENTRANCE.

The Government of Queensland has given Notice, dated 25th July, 1882, that the Commander of the Colonial Government schooner Pearl reports having found a rock with 4½ feet over it at low water spring tides, lying in Mourilyan harbour entrance, with Goodman rock bearing N. ½ W., distant 60 yards. Also, other rocks awash at low water, lying with Goodman rock bearing N.W., distant 30 yards.

Note.—The available channel, which is between these dangers, is only 40 yards in width, and must be used with the greatest caution.

(The bearings are Magnetic. Variation 61° Easterly in 1882.)

SOUTH COAST-MOYNE RIVER ENTRANCE.

(1) PORT FAIRY—HARBOUR LIGHT ON SOUTHERN DIKE.

(1) FORT FAIRY—HARBOUR LIGHT ON SOUTHERN DIKE. The Government of Victoria has given Notice, that on 14th August, 1882, a light would be exhibited from the extremity of the southern dike forming the entrance to Moyne river:—

The light is a fixed light, and is cut to show red to clear the black buoy off the river entrance, round westerly over the foul ground to Guiffith island; and white from the black buoy, round easterly over the river entrance. It should be visible in clear weather from a distance of about 3 miles.

NORTH COAST—CLARENCE STRAIT.

(2) VERNON ISLANDS—BUOYS MARKING PASSAGE BETWEEN.

The Government of South Australia has given Notice, dated 11th September, 1882, that large iron cheese-shaped buoys, having pyramidal open frame-work surmounted by balls, have replaced those which formerly marked the usual passage between the Vernon islands, south side of Clarence strait:—

The buoy, placed off the north-west extremity of Henry Ellis reef, South Vernon island, is coloured black, and moored in 17 fathoms water. The buoy marking the end of the spit extending to the westward from the south-west point of East Vernon island, is coloured red.

These buoys are about 24 miles apart.

NOTE.—A mid-channel course is recommended when passing through, either to the eastward or to the westward.
