A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the sixty-seventh section of "The Customs Laws Consolidation Act, 1882," it is, among other things, enacted that the importation of arms, ammunition, gunpowder, or any other goods may be prohibited by Proclamation or Order in Council: And whereas it is expedient that the importation of the goods hereinafter mentioned should be prohibited:

Now, therefore, I, James Prendergast, the Administrator of the Government of the Colony of New Zealand, in exercise and pursuance of the said power and authority, do hereby order and proclaim that the importation into New Zealand of grape-vines, grape-vine cuttings, and grapes shall be and the same is prohibited.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir James Prendergast, Knight, Chief Justice, the Administrator of the Government of Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, at the Government House, at Wellington, this tenth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three.
