“Meda,” in Cossack Creek,

4th August, 1883.

SIR,

I have the honor to inform Your Excellency that we arrived here from Roebuck Bay on the 1st instant, having completed our survey of that port, which embraced fourteen miles east and west and twelve miles north and south, on the scale of three inches to the mile. Upon the completion of that service, we proceeded to define the approaches to certain limits lying beyond our plan, by obtaining additional soundings for the published sheet 1048.

In carrying out this latter service, I regret to have to report that at 9:40 a.m. of the 26th July the “Meda” struck upon a dangerous unknown rock, lying S.W. by W. $\frac{3}{4}$ W., distant $8\frac{1}{2}$ miles from the north entrance point of the Bay. This rock has only one foot of water over it, and $3\frac{1}{2}$ fathoms, muddy bottom, all round, and constitutes a formidable danger in the approach to Roebuck Bay. Correct astronomical position—latitude, $18^{\circ} 3' 50''$ S.; longitude, $122^{\circ} 4' 30''$ W.

The wind was blowing very fresh from the eastward at the time, and we were under reduced canvas, going five or six knots an hour. The hand-lead gave regular soundings of $4\frac{1}{4}$ fathoms, mud bottom, up to the moment of striking. I had left the deck in charge of Lieutenant Tooker barely ten minutes, when we struck hard, and floated again immediately.

By noon we had placed the vessel on the beach in Roebuck Bay, and were thus enabled to ascertain the nature and extent of our injuries, which proved to be less than we had reason to anticipate from the force of the blow.

Six feet of starboard side of keel was gone, commencing two feet abaft the forefoot, and carrying with it a portion of the garboard strake. Some metal was also gone.

We made no water on our way down nor at any time since striking.

We have made good our defects, sufficient to meet present requirements, at a slight cost for skilled labor.

2. So soon as opportunity shall permit us to leave this Creek, we shall proceed to the Ashburton River, to survey that anchorage.

3. I regret that under present circumstances we cannot undertake the risk of approaching Hampton Harbor and the Fortescue River, and an examination of those anchorages must therefore be postponed.

4. The directions for Roebuck Bay and Fitzroy River will be furnished to Your Excellency by next opportunity.

5. It is my agreeable duty to report to Your Excellency that of the natives we have met during our stay in these waters, those employed in the pearling industry seem happy and contented with their occupation, and appear better fed than non-pearling natives. The pearling industry has had a perceptible civilising influence in the places we have visited eastward of Cossack; and the assistance offered to us by the natives of King Sound and Roebuck Bay was, I believe, due to that influence.
