WHEREAS by divers Acts of the Imperial Legislature, it is made lawful for the Governor of Western Australia, for the time being, to fix such place within any part of the said Colony, and such time for holding every Session of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, as he may think fit; Now THEREFORE I, FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, C.M.G., being Governor as aforesaid, in exercise of the powers so in me vested, do hereby announce and proclaim that a SESSION OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA shall commence and be holden for despatch of business on THURSDAY, THE TENTH DAY OF JULY NEXT, at the hour of THREE o'clock in the AFTERNOON, in the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, in the CITY OF PERTH, in the said Colony; and the Members of the Legislative Council are hereby required to give their attendance at the same time and place accordingly.

By His Excellency FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, Esquire, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c. &c.

WHEREAS by a Deed Poll of Grant bearing date the first day of September, 1877, under the hand of the Governor and Public Seal of the Colony, the land described and designated in Victoria Location 956 was granted to William Carr; and whereas by the said Deed Poll power was reserved to the Crown to resume and enter upon possession of any part of the said land which it might at any time by the Crown be deemed necessary to resume for making roads, canals, bridges, towing paths, or other works of public utility or convenience; so, nevertheless, that the lands to be resumed should not exceed one-twentieth part in the whole of the land so granted, and that no resumption should be made of any lands upon which any buildings may have been erected, or which may be in use as gardens or otherwise for the more convenient occupation of any such buildings; and whereas the piece or parcel of land hereinafter described is necessary for the purposes of a Public Road: Now KNOW YE that Her Most Gracious Majesty doth hereby, and by virtue of the said power and authority reserved and contained in the said recited Deed Poll, resume, for the purposes aforesaid, all that portion of Victoria Location 956, bounded on the North by part of the North boundary of Victoria Location 956, extending West about thirty-seven chains ten links from its North-east corner to the eastern side of a public road from Greenough to Geraldton; on the South by a line parallel to the North boundary and at a distance of fifty links south therefrom; on the East by part of the eastern boundary of the aforesaid Location 956, extending southward from its North-east corner, and being the western side of a public road from Greenough to Geraldton *via* "Rudd's Gully"; and on the

West by the eastern side of the public road first mentioned from Greenough to Geraldton, marked on the plans and in the books of the Office of the Surveyor General (not exceeding, however, in the whole one-twentieth of the said Grant, nor being otherwise improved within the meaning of the said Grant).

AUSTRALIA—SOUTH COAST.

ENCOUNTER BAY.

(1) PORT VICTOR—FIXED LIGHT ON BREAKWATER.

The Government of South Australia has given Notice, that on 31st December 1883, a light would be exhibited from a tripod on the extremity of the breakwater at Port Victor, West side of Encounter Bay:—

The light is a fixed white light, elevated 26 feet above high water, and should be visible in clear weather from a distance of about 5 miles.

Position, lat. 35° 34' 30" S., long. 138° 38' 15" E.

NOTE.—Vessels approaching from the South-West, should not steer towards the port until this light bears N.W., and by keeping it on that bearing, should pass about 2½ cables Eastward of Seal Rock.

PORT PHILLIP.

(2) TORPEDO GROUND IN HOBSON BAY.

The Government of Victoria has given Notice, that lines of electric cables, and experimental submarine mines have been laid in Hobson Bay, Port Phillip:—

The space appropriated as Torpedo ground lies Southward of Williamstown breakwater pier, and is comprised between lines drawn from Gellibrand light-vessel to the outer extremity of that breakwater pier, and from the light-vessel to Gellibrand old lighthouse—Mariners are cautioned not to anchor in the vicinity.

TORRES STRAIT—WESTERN APPROACH.

POSITION OF PROUDFOOT SHOAL LIGHT-VESSEL.

With reference to Notice to Mariners, No. 2 (2), of 4th January 1884, on placing a light-vessel about one mile South-West of Proudfoot shoal, Western approach to Torres strait:—

The Government of Queensland has given further Notice, that on 1st December 1883, the light-vessel was placed in 10 fathoms water, 1 and 3-10ths miles S.W. of Proudfoot shoal.

The light is an occulting light, showing a white light for ten seconds at intervals of four seconds; it is elevated 40 feet above the sea, and should be visible in clear weather from a distance of about 11 miles.

The illuminating apparatus is dioptric, or by lenses, of the fifth order.

Position, lat. 10° 32' 10" S., long. 141° 27' 15" E.

The bearing is Magnetic. Variation 43° Easterly in 1884.
