PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS the Legislative Council stands prorogued until the 15th of October next; AND WHEREAS for divers weighty reasons it is desirable that the said Legislative Council should be dissolved: Now THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers and authority in me vested as Governor of the said Colony, I, FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, do hereby dissolve the Legislative Council of Western Australia from and after the fifteenth of September instant, and the same stands dissolved accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Colony, at Government House, Perth, this thirteenth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four.
