PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

WHEREAS by my Proclamation dated Government House, Perth, the eighth day of September, 1884, I, the said Governor, did notify and proclaim that a length of 200 feet of the New South Jetty, from the sea end, which shall include the whole of the head, shall be a place where Quarantine may be performed by vessels, persons, or things liable to Quarantine in the Port of Fremantle, in addition to any place or places which may have already been declared or proclaimed to be Quarantine Ground or Grounds; AND WHEREAS the said place of Quarantine is no longer required for such purpose: NOW THEREFORE I, the said Governor, do hereby notify that the said recited Proclamation is hereby repealed.

Given under my hand and issued under the Public Seal of the said Colony, at Government House, Perth, this fifteenth day of September, 1884.
