NOTICE is hereby given that, on and after this date, a Revolving Light will be exhibited from the highest part of Double Island Point, at an elevation of 315 feet above the sea.

The apparatus is of the 3rd Order, holophotal dioptric, and the light, which is visible for a distance of 24 miles, attains its greatest brillancy at intervals of 30 seconds.

The tower from which the light is exhibited is circular, and painted stone color.
