HEREAS in the Session of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, holden in the forty-eighth year of the reign of Her present Majesty, the following Bills were passed, viz.:-"An Act to provide for the Registration of certain Persons who shall be imported into Western Australia or employed in any manner within the Territorial Dominion thereof, and for certain other matters in connection therewith," and "An Act for raising the sum of Five Hundred and Twenty-five Thousand Pounds by Loan for the construction of certain Public Works;" And whereas such Bills were reserved for the signification of Her Majesty's pleasure thereon: Now therefore I, Alexander CAMPBELL ONSLOW, Administrator of the Government of the said Colony, do hereby signify and proclaim that such Bills have been laid before Her Majesty in Council, and that Her Majesty has been pleased to assent to the same.
