TORRES STRAIT—GREAT NORTH-EAST CHANNEL.

SHOAL SOUTH-WEST OF NINEPIN ROCK.

The French Government has given Notice—on the authority of the Commander of the French vessel *Vétéran*—of the existence of a shoal lying about 3 miles south-westward of Ninepin rock, in the course recommended through the Great North-east channel to Torres strait:—

This shoal (*Vétéran shoal*) is stated to extend in the shape of a crescent (concave side to the north-west) for a distance of about one cable in a north-east and south-west direction, with a breadth of about a quarter of a cable, and judging from the color of the water, the depth was estimated to be about $2\frac{1}{2}$ fathoms; it lies with the following approximate bearings:—

Ninepin rock	N.E.
Burke island summit	N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ W.

Approximate position, Lat. $10^{\circ} 16' S.$, Long. $142^{\circ} 38\frac{1}{2}' E.$
(The bearings are Magnetic. Variation $4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ Easterly in 1885.)

3. Those lying between the mouths of the Fortescue and Cane Rivers, extending six miles from shore.
