SCAB DISTRICTS.—CENTRAL.

Bounded on the North by the South boundary of the Victoria District; on the West by the sea coast including the islands adjacent to it; on the South by an East line from the sea coast passing along the south side of Rockingham townsite to the Perth-Albany Road, from thence in a North-easterly direction to Mount Dale, from thence in a South-east direction to the Hotham River, from thence upward along the river aforesaid to Millingnalling Pool, and thence by a due East line, including the sea coast and islands adjacent to it; and on the East by the East boundary of the Colony.

SOUTH-WEST.

Dale.

SOUTH-EAST.

Bounded on the North by the South boundary of the Central District; on the West by the East boundary of the South-west District; and on the South by the sea coast including the islands adjacent to it.

The Scab Districts gazetted 21st November, 1882, are hereby cancelled.
