II Excellency the Governor, on the recommendation of the Kimberley Roads Board, has been pleased to declare the following Roads to be Main Roads.

A road leaving Derby Townsite, and extending in a North-easterly direction, passing Bungarlwoodyne Well to a clay pan near survey mark H21; from thence in a Southeasterly direction passing through Reserve 949 to the southern side of the Mary River; thence eastward along the said river passing to the South of Mount Marmion, and along the South side of Lennard River to Wingrah Pool near the Devil's Pass, in Napier Range.

A road leaving the last described road at a spot Southwest of Mount Marmion and extending in a North-east and northerly direction, crossing the Lennard River and Poulton's crossing; thence to a water hole on the western side of Hawkstone Peak; thence in a North-easterly direction to the eastern side of a sandstone hill in lease  $\frac{1}{2HT}$ , and from thence in a North-westerly direction to a pool in Robinson River, near the junction with it of its South branch.
