**I**N pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1884," I, SIR FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, Governor of the said Colony, do by this my Proclamation appoint

*Monday, the 1st day of March proximo,*

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at the towns of Perth, Fremantle, and York of the said Colony.
