A BILL to provide for the Licensing of Land Surveyors.

WHEREAS it is desirable to regulate, in certain respects, the practice of Land Surveying in the Colony of Western Australia: Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:----

1. THE Governor may from time to time appoint a Board of Examiners, consisting of not less than three members, one of whom Appointment of Board of Examiners. shall be the Surveyor General of the Colony for the time being, who shall be the President of such Board, under the style and description of "The Land Surveyors Licensing Board," and the Governor may from time to time remove the said members, or any or either of them, and on the removal, death, resignation, or absence from the Colony of the said members, or any or either of them, shall appoint such other person or persons as he shall think fit.

THE Board may, with the approval of the Governor, make Board may make rules for the conduct of examinations under this Act.

3. IT shall be lawful for the said Board to recommend to the Governor for appointment, for the purposes of this Act, fit and Governor on recom-mendation of Board proper persons whose qualifications for the office shall have been may appoint Licensed satisfactorily ascertained by the said Board, and the Governor may appoint such persons without salary, to be termed Licensed Surveyors.

4. SURVEYS made by such Licensed Surveyors shall, on verification and approval by the Surveyor General, be accepted by the Government will ac-Survey Department of the Government and adopted in all questions Licensed Surveyors. between the Government and the occupiers of any demised waste lands of the Crown and between the occupiers of any such demised land as correct surveys.

5. PERSONS applying to be licensed for the purposes of this Act shall, when required, submit to an examination by the said Surveyors may be examined prior to Board, which shall inquire into the qualification of such applicant issue of License. and shall also in all cases require to be satisfied that the applicant is a person of good fame and character.

6. EVERY Surveyor prior to receiving a license shall make a statutory declaration before one of Her Majesty's Justices of the Surveyors to make declaration and give Peace for the Colony, in the form annexed in Schedule A, that bond. he will perform all surveys entrusted to him with strict impartiality, and in accordance with such rules and regulations as shall be prescribed by the Surveyor General with the approval of the Governor, and shall also at the same time enter into a joint and several bond to Her Majesty, with two sufficient sureties, and in a sum to be approved by the Surveyor General, conditioned to the effect of the aforesaid declaration.

7. EVERY Surveyor appointed under this Act shall receive a license, in the form annexed in Schedule B, signed by the Governor.

8. EVERY Surveyor shall pay to the Colonial Treasurer the sum of Five pounds for such license aforesaid, provided that such fee shall not be charged in the case of licenses issued to Surveyors practising as such in Western Australia previous to the first day of June, 1886.

9. IT shall be lawful for any Licensed Surveyor to charge and receive, from such party or parties as may employ him, such fees as are provided for in Schedule C hereto annexed.

10. IT shall be lawful for the said Board, with the approval of the Governor, to revoke any such license at any time by notice in the *Government Gazette*.

11. THE words "Licensed Surveyor," when used in any Act hereafter to be passed, shall be construed to mean a person licensed under the provisions of this Act.

12. ANY person who shall wilfully and falsely pretend to be licensed under this Act, or who shall take or use the name or title of Licensed Surveyor, or any name, title, addition, or description implying that he is licensed under this Act, shall, upon summary conviction before one or more Justices of the Peace in Petty Sessions, pay a sum not exceeding One hundred pounds.

13. THE said Board shall once at least in every year cause to be published in the *Government Gazette* a correct register of all persons licensed under this Act, with the respective residences of such persons as far as known to the Board.

14. A LICENSE granted under the provisions of this Act shall not entitle the holder thereof to practise as a Surveyor under "The Transfer of Land Act, 1874."

15. THIS Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Licensed Surveyors Act, 1886."

SCHEDULES REFERRED TO.

B., do solemnly and sincerely declare that I will, to the best of my ability and without partiality, favor, or affection, correctly survey and delineate the boundaries of such lands as may be entrusted to me to be surveyed, and in accordance with such Rules and Regulations as shall be prescribed by the Surveyor General with the approval of the Governor where the same apply.

Having satisfactorily proved your qualifications to the Land Surveyors Licensing Board constituted under "The Licensed Surveyors Act, 1886," I do hereby, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the said Act, appoint you, the said A.B., to be a Licensed Land Surveyor for the Colony of Western Australia under the provisions of the said Act.

A BILL to authorise the granting of exclusive Licenses, within defined areas in the waters of Sharks Bay, for Pearl Shell Fishing.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. IT shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands, with the approval of the Governor, to grant licenses to any person or persons to gather, collect. and remove pearls and pearl shells in and from the waters of Sharks Bay, within a defined area to be specified in every such license.

2. EVERY such license shall be in the form in the Schedule hereto annexed, or to the like effect, and under the hand of the Commissioner of Crown Lands and countersigned by the Governor; and every such license shall entitle the licensee, his agents and servants, to the sole right to gather, collect, and remove pearls and pearl shells within and from the area defined in the license.

3. LICENSES may be for any period not exceeding three years, and at such annual fee, payable in advance, and subject to such conditions (to be expressed in the license) as the Commissioner of Crown Lands, with the approval aforesaid, may determine.

4. ALL applications for licenses shall be made to the Commissioner of Crown Lands, in such form as he may approve, and shall be accompanied with an accurate description of the area applied for and an application fee of Twenty shillings. The said Commissioner shall not be bound to receive or entertain any such application, and he may invite tenders for any license or licenses, but shall not be bound to accept the highest or any tender.

5. NO license shall be transferred, sublet, or assigned, except with the written permission of the Commissioner of Crown Lands, countersigned by the Governor, and on payment of a fee of Ten shillings on application for such permission.

6. LICENSEES may determine their licenses by giving to the Commissioner of Crown Lands three months notice of their intention so to do, but no part of the license fee shall in any case be refunded.

7. ON non-payment of rent on the day named in the license, or the breach or non-observance of any term or condition of a license, the Governor may declare such license forfeited, and thereupon the same shall be absolutely void, and notice of any such declaration of forfeiture shall be forthwith published in the *Govern*ment Gazette.

8. ALL pearls and pearl shells lying or contained within the limits of any licensed area shall, during the continuance of the license, be deemed to be the absolute property of the licensee for all purposes civil or criminal; and all and every person or persons who shall gather, collect, or remove any pearl or pearl shells within or from the limits of a licensed area, without the authority of the licensee or his agent, shall be deemed guilty of larceny and may be summarily convicted of such offence before one or more justices in petty sessions.

9. SHARKS Bay, for the purposes of this Act, shall include all the waters being within the following limits: Bounded by a Southwest line from Charles Point, on the mainland, to Cape Ronsard, at the North end of Bernier Island; then by the western shores of

Bernier and Dorré Islands to Cape St. Cricq; then by a straight line to Cape Inscription, at the North end of Dirk Hartog Island, and by its Western shore to Surf Point; thence by a straight line to Steep Point on the mainland, and from thence by the coast-line to the starting place at Charles Point; and on the inner part by the outlines of the islands in the Bay.

10. FROM and after the day of 1886, it shall not be lawful for any person, except he be licensed under this Act or be the agent or servant of or otherwise authorised by a person holding a license under this Act and be pearling within the area held under any such license, to gather, collect, or remove pearls or pearl shells in and from the waters of Sharks Bay, and every person offending against this provision shall be liable, on summary conviction before any two or more Justices of the Peace in Petty Sessions, to a penalty not exceeding One hundred pounds, and upon such conviction the convicting justices may cause to be seized and detained for a period of three months from such seizure, unless such penalty be sooner paid, any and every ship or boat (together with everything on board the same) used or employed by any such convicted person in the illegal gathering, collection, or removal of any such pearls or pearl shells, and at the expiration of such period of three months shall, unless the penalty be then paid, declare such ship or boat, together with everything on board the same, to be forfeited to Her Majesty, and such ship or boat, together with everything on board the same, shall thereupon be forfeited accordingly, and shall be sold and the proceeds dealt with as the proceeds of a Provided always, that notwithstanding anything in this penalty. section contained the payment of any such penalty, or so much thereof as shall not be realised by such sale as aforesaid, may be enforced by any means provided by law for the general enforcement of penalties.

11. SECTIONS lettered A, F, G, and H, in the Schedule of "The Shortening Ordinance, 1853," shall be incorporated with and taken to form part of this Act to all intents and purposes, and in as full and ample a manner as if the said sections had been introduced and fully set forth in this Act.

12. THIS Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Sharks Bay Pearl Shell Fishery Act, 188 ."

SCHEDULE.

KNOW all men by these presents that A.B., of *(if more than one person, alter form accordingly)*, his executors, administrators, and permitted assigns, is and are hereby licensed, by himself and themselves, and his and their agents and servants, to gather and collect Pearls and Pearl Shells by dredging or otherwise, and to remove the same within and from the waters of Sharks Bay within the area described hereunder, for the term of years from the date hereof, he and they paying to the Commissioner of Crown Lands, or his appointee, the yearly sum of \pounds in advance, on every day of without deduction.

On non-payment of rent or the breach or non-observance of any term or condition of this License, the Governor may declare the same forfeited.
