PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Frederick NAPIER BROOME, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-F. Napier Broome, Governor. in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

THEREAS under the provisions of an Act of the Legislative Council, passed in the 43rd year of the reign of Her present Majesty, numbered 23, intituled "An Act for the prevention of the Importation of Diseased Stock," the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is empowered by Proclamation to prohibit the introduction into the Colony, either by land or sea, of any cattle within the meaning of the said Act and of "The Cattle Diseases Ordinance, 1865," and "The Imported Stock Act, 1876," or either of them: Now therefore I, the said Governor, in exercise of such power and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, do by this Proclamation, with the advice of the Executive Council, prohibit the Importation into, and landing in, Western Australia, either by land or sea, from Great Britain or Ireland, or from any other place beyond the limits of the Australasian Colonies, of all horned cattle, sheep, and swine.
