By His Excellency Sir FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of "The Bank Holidays Act, 1884," I, Sir FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, Governor of the said Colony, do by this Proclamation appoint

Wednesday, the 18th instant,

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday in the city of Perth and in the town of Fremantle, in the said Colony.
