## PROCLAMATION

Western Australia, }

By His Excellency SIR FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS it is provided by "The Sandalwood Act, 1881," that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, from time to time, to proclaim and define the Waste Lands of the Crown within which no live or growing Sandalwood tree shall be cut or grubbed up, during the period to be named by the Governor in such Proclamation: Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim and define the Waste Lands of the Crown contained and being within the following area, to be an area within which no live or growing Sandalwood tree shall be cut or grubbed up, during the period of three years from the date hereof:—

*Victoria District.*—Bounded on the South by a line fifty miles in length, extending East from the sea coast, from a spot fifty miles South of Dongara; on the Eastward by lines extending Northward from the East end of the South boundary to a spot fifty miles East from Dongara; from thence in a North-westerly direction through a spot situate fifty miles East from Geraldton to Pelican Pool in the Murchison River; from thence by the said river downwards to the sea coast, and by the sea coast in a Southerly direction to the starting point.

At a meeting held at Apsley House, on February 21st, 1888, it was announced that the above Committee had been formed, on the invitation of His Excellency the Lord Vivian, Her Majesty's Minister at Brussels, for the purpose of raising funds for the erection and preservation of a monument in memory of the British officers, non-commissioned officers, and men who lost their lives in the Waterloo campaign.

No memorial at present exists, and the opportunity is now taken of the old cemeteries at Brussels being removed, and the remains of our soldiers buried there, and in the farms round Mont St. Jean, being placed in the new cemetery at Evère outside the town, to appeal to the country for funds to erect a monument, worthy of those who fought for England in the battles of 1815.

It was also proposed that the object of the meeting should be communicated to the whole of Great Britain and her Colonies, in order that the subscription should assume a thoroughly National form. Lord Vivian estimates that £3,500 will be required to carry out the object in a desirable manner. Over £2,000 has already been collected.
