WHEREAS by divers Acts of the Imperial Legislature, it is made lawful for the Governor of Western Australia, for the time being, to fix such place within any part of the said Colony, and such time for holding every Session of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, as he may think fit; NOW THEREFORE I, SIR FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, K.C.M.G., being Governor as aforesaid, in exercise of the powers so in me vested, do hereby announce and proclaim that a SESSION of the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL of WESTERN AUSTRALIA shall commence and be holden for despatch of business on WEDNESDAY, THE TENTH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, at the hour of THREE o'clock in the AFTERNOON, in the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, in the CITY OF PERTH, in the said Colony; and the Members of the Legislative Council are hereby required to give their attendance at the same time and place accordingly.

San Francisco, May 10, 1888.
I have the honor to inclose copy of a letter which I received this morning from the Imperial German Consul relative to trade with the Marshall Islands.

There is some trade in schooners from San Francisco with these islands, but the vessels are under the American flag.

Upon making inquiries here, I find that the vessels under the British flag trading there usually hail from the Australian Colonies.

Sir,
San Francisco, May 1, 1888.
The Imperial German Government has declared the port of Yalint to be the only port of entry of the Marshall Islands.

The masters of those ships which come from any port outside of said islands have to enter the port of Yalint, and to report to the Imperial Commissioner at said last-mentioned port before touching any other one of the said islands.

Any violation of any of the foregoing provisions shall be punishable by fine not exceeding 6,000 marks. This fine may be enforced against the ship and cargo without regard to the owner of the same, and the forfeiture of the ship may be adjudged.

It being desirable that all parties concerned receive timely notice of the foregoing, I would most respectfully request you to have the masters of such ships as are under your official control and may go to the Marshall Islands informed of the above requirements.
