**W**HEREAS by divers Acts of the Imperial Legislature, it is made lawful for the Governor of Western Australia, for the time being, to fix such place within any part of the said Colony, and such time for holding every Session of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, as he may think fit; Now THEREFORE I, SIR FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, K.C.M.G., being Governor as aforesaid, in exercise of the powers so in me vested, do hereby announce and proclaim that a SESSION of the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL of WESTERN AUSTRALIA shall commence and be holden for despatch of business on WEDNESDAY, THE TENTH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, at the hour of THREE o'clock in the AFTERNOON, in the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, in the CITY OF PERTH, in the said Colony; and the Members of the Legislative Council are hereby required to give their attendance at the same time and place accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said Colony, at Government House, this 25th day of July, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight.

SIR,

I have the honor to bring under your notice that I have just received a letter from Arthur S. King, Esq., Stock and Station Agent, Bourke St. W., Melbourne, cautioning me against the sheep of China, Japan and Corea, which (he has been informed by a gentleman in China, who formerly worked amongst sheep and cattle in these Colonies) are suffering from a disease which he describes as very much like scurvy in the human being.

"It breaks out—he informs me—at the roots of the ears, then the mouth and nose, and then spreads over the whole body."

Tobacco and Sulphur dip is said to be the cure.
