IS Excellency the Governor has been pleased to approve the following By-Laws passed by the Rockingham Commonage Board, relative to the depasturing of cattle, sheep, &c., on the Commonage lands (Reserve No. 1486).

#### JOHN FORREST, Commissioner of Crown Lands.

- 1. The land to be reserved exclusively as a pasture for those cattle and horses which are the bond fide home stock belonging to their tenancy, provided that owners of land within the boundaries mentioned in Rule 2 but not owning or renting stock can, by applying to the Committee, have the privilege of having twenty head of stock belonging to
- The home stock to mean the usual stock and increase attaching to each occupancy. Resident occupiers shall mean all persons owning or renting freehold or conditional purchase land and residing upon or within the following boundaries:—Bounded on the South and East by Cockburn Sound Location 16; on the North by a West line passing along North boundary of Location 241; on the West by the East side of the public road Southwards to a point one chain due East of the South-east corner of Location 244, thence West along South boundary of Location 244 to the sea, thence by coast to North corner of Rockingham Town-site, thence by the whole of the North boundary and part of the East boundary of said Townsite to the West end of the South boundary.
  - Pasturing of sheep or goats strictly prohibited.
- All stock found on the land contrary to the foregoing stipulations will be treated as trespassing, and dealt with according to law.

Explanatory Notes on Clauses 46, 47, 48, 49, 54, and 55 of the Land Regulations of 1887.

Crown Lands' Office, Perth, December 20th, 1889.

PPLICANTS for land should be careful to ascertain which clause of the Land Regulations is most advantageous in their particular case, and should always state clearly, when applying for land, the Clause of the Regulations they wish to come under. In order that the above Conditional Purchase Clauses may be clearly understood, the following explanations have been prepared for general information:—

Clause 46.—This clause is only to be used in applying for land within a surveyed agricultural area.

- 2. An applicant must not be under 18 years of age, and must reside upon a portion of the land taken up.
- 3. The area held by one person must not be less than 100 acres nor more than 1,000 acres, and may be in three blocks but no more.
- $4.\ \,$  The rent is 6d. an acre for 20 years, payable on 1st March in each year.
- 5. The improvements required are, that within 2 years one-tenth of the land shall be fenced, and the whole within 5 years—and, within the 20 years, ten shillings an acre has to be expended on the land.
- 6. At any time after 5 years, if all the improvements are completed and the full 20 years rent paid, the title deed will issue.

Clause 47.—This clause is intended for those who possess land under former Regulations, and reside upon a portion of such land, and is applicable either within an agricultural area or outside of it.

- 2. By this clause a person can take up from 100 to  $1{,}000$  acres anywhere within 10 miles of his homestead.
- 3. The rent is 6d. an acre for 20 years, and the conditions, excepting residence, exactly the same as under Clause 46.

Clause 48.—This clause is intended for those who wish to apply for land outside an agricultural area.

- 2. An applicant must reside upon a portion of the land within 6 months from the date of survey.
- 3. The rent and all other conditions are exactly the same as under Clause 46; the only difference being that Clause 46 is intended for a surveyed agricultural area, and Clause 48 for land outside of an agricultural area.

Clause 49.—This clause is intended for those who do not reside upon their own land, and who do not wish to reside upon the land taken up, or by those who reside upon their own land and wish to take land situated more than 10 miles from their residence, without residing upon it.

2. This clause is equally available for land within an agricultural area and land outside of an area.

3. Under this clause the annual rent is one shilling an acre, and the conditions, excepting residence, the same as under Clause 46.

Clause 54.—This clause is intended for those who wish to pay ten per cent. of the purchase money (viz., 10s. an acre) on application, and the balance within one month after the application has been approved.

- This clause is equally available for land within an agricultural area and land outside of an area.
- 3. Residence is not required under this clause. From 100 to 5,000 acres, in not more than 3 blocks, can be obtained.
- 4. The improvements required are, that the land shall be fenced in within 3 years from the date of survey, and 5s. an acre expended upon it in improvements within 7 years from such date.

Clause 55.—This clause is intended for those persons who require land for vineyards, orchards, and gardens in small blocks of from 5 acres to 20 acres, either within an agricultural area if small blocks have been surveyed in it, or outside of an area.

- 2. Residence is not required.
- 3. Not more than 20 acres can be obtained under this clause by any one person.
  - 4. The price per acre must not be less than £1.
- 5. The improvements required are that the land shall be fenced, and one-tenth part shall be planted with vines or fruit trees, within 3 years from the date of survey.
- 6. If the land required is outside the South-West Division, it must be within a special area or within 10 miles of a townsite.
